

How to access the VitalSource Bookshelf

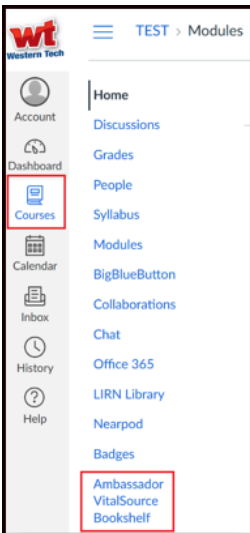
Via Canvas LMS

Login to the LMS Canvas (<https://westerntech.instructure.com>)

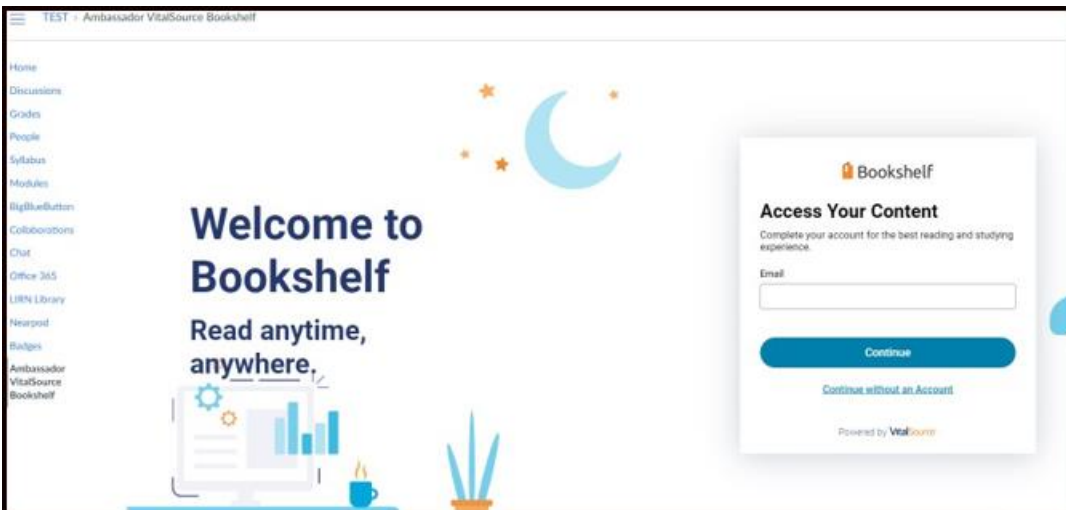


Open your course, then select **Ambassador VitalSource Bookshelf** located in the navigation menu.



Once the page loads it will display the following image. Type in your school email address that has been given to you and select **Continue**.




On the next page, you will create your account. Enter your first and last name and then type in your school email address and a new password. Then check the box to accept terms of use and then select “Create Account”.
